To apply, complete this form by describing the proposed project or materials to be funded along with the number of students who will benefit from the activity or resources. Your budget summary should include a breakdown of all specific costs involved.

Grants are reviewed in two cycles each year. Grant applications are due on Fall Cycle applications are due by November 30th. Spring Cycle applications are due by May 31st.

Please note that priority will be given to grants that further our FREF mission to enhance the educational needs of our students.

Effective: January 2020

1. Applicant must be a current staff member in good standing in the Flemington Raritan School District.

2. Completed application forms should be mailed to:

3. The FREF Board offers two grant cycles. Grants to be considered in the Fall Cycle must be submitted by November 30th of the given year. Grants to be considered in the Spring Cycle must be submitted by May 31st of the given year.

4. Applicant will be notified of approval/denial within two weeks of the FREF Board's review. Following the FREF Board's approval, the grant will then be subject to review and approval by the FRSD Board of Education.

5. A record of all applications will be kept with the Flemington Raritan Education Foundation.

6. Grant funds will not be approved and distributed until all budgeted funds have been allocated.

7. All items purchased with Flemington Raritan Education Foundation funding become the property of the Flemington Raritan School District and are to remain at the appropriate school or designated site.
