Public Hearing of Incidents



Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:17-46, school districts are required to provide a public hearing on incidents reported to the New Jersey Department of Education.

The following data is based on state-mandated reports completed by our building principals. Using definitions and guidelines provided by the New Jersey Department of Education, principals are responsible for reporting all incidents of violence, vandalism, false public alarm, weapon possession, HIB (alleged and confirmed), substance use, and all other incidents leading to student removal. The reports are then submitted to the Assistant Superintendent who reviews them, and is ultimately responsible for ensuring that they are electronically submitted to the New Jersey Department of Education.

Violence

- Simple Threat - 3 (RFIS & JPC)
- Criminal Threat - 1 (RH)
- Assault on another student - 4 (RFIS & JPC)
- Assault on staff member - 4 (RH)
- Fight - 7 (RFIS & JPC)

Vandalism

- School exterior - 1 (BS)

Other Incidents

- Inappropriate physical contact
- Inappropriate language
- Inappropriate behavior in bathroom
- Insubordination & defiance
- Attempting to leave school

Threat, Simple - Attempting by physical menace (e.g., verbal threats) to put another in fear of bodily injury. The offender knew that the threat could make the victim fearful.

Threat, Criminal - Expressing - either physically or verbally - the intent to commit one of the following violent criminal offenses: homicide, aggravated assault, sexual assault, kidnapping, arson.

Assault - A person attempts to cause – or purposely, knowingly, or recklessly causes – bodily injury to another.

Fight - Mutual engagement in a physical confrontation in which the offenders understood that the confrontation may result in bodily injury to either party. Does not include a verbal confrontation or a minor confrontation, such as a shoving match. Each participant must be classified as an offender.

Other Incidents Leading to Removal - These are incidents that do not meet the criteria for violence, vandalism, substance, weapons, or HIB Alleged or Confirmed, but do lead to removal of a student from the educational placement for a half day or more.
